WILDWOOD FALL TRAIL WORK

It is time to get the Wildwood Trail in shape for another season. We need volunteers to help with the trail work on Sunday, October 14th. We will meet at the trailhead at 9:00 a.m. to work on the trail, and when the work is finished we will go to the home of John and Becky Hooper for a dinner of yak burgers and all of the fixin's - UNLESS our crayfish supplier comes through with enough to make e'touffee the entrée for the day. Whatever the main dish, Becky has again promised that she'll have some homemade pecan pie ready for the trail workers.

Please call John at 320-685-4489 to let him know that you are coming. And please note that it is important that you arrive promptly at 9:00 a.m., because once the crews are spread out over the trail system it is difficult to connect with latecomers. The trail work should take 4 to 6 hours, so bring water and a snack. We'll be clearing deadfalls and brush from the trail, and we'll have any tools or equipment that is needed. Be sure to wear good work gloves.

CROSS-COUNTY SKI PATROL VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

For experienced cross-country skiers the Stearns County Park Department has an easy volunteer opportunity that will earn you a twelve-month Quarry Park & Nature Preserve Vehicle Permit.

Cross-country ski patrol volunteers provide information to skiers, record observations and provide needed assistance. The County Park Department will provide a short orientation.

To receive a Quarry Park & Nature Preserve Vehicle Permit, a volunteer must sign up for two shifts of two hours each at one of the three parks, and come to orientation. The Ski Patrol will operate December 15, 2007 thru February 29, 2008.
